Vertical stone towers anchor these levels to each other and to their site on the border between commercial and residential neighborhoods.

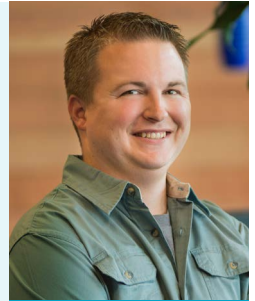

Fun Fact: This year, he and his wife will celebrate their 25th Anniversary in Hawaii!

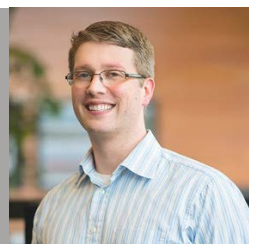
