SENIOR HOUSING - MEMORY CARE

This two-story, coastal contemporary senior community in Torrance, California, is a 60 bed, 37,000 SF building along the dazzling Pacific Coast Highway.

Despite a restrictive site and extra setbacks, Lenity was able to incorporate an outdoor courtyard for the residents. Density was achieved by adding a second story extension over the parking and access drive aisle. The building strikes a comfortable balance between commercial and residential with the mixed use of materials including stone, stucco, lap and wood siding. The primary crisp white and soft ocean green color palette was inspired by the breaking waves and subtle hues of the nearby Pacific Ocean.
